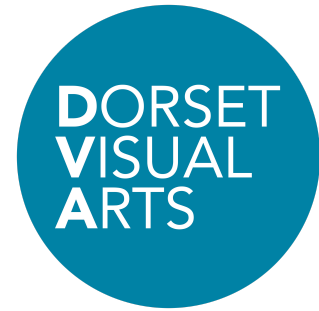


## Emerging Artist Mentor

The mentor will also be required to produce digital resources for emerging artists.
